

## Mirror Lake Covid-19 Guidelines

- Face coverings and masks are required in public places where social distancing is not possible. The order requires any person over the age of 2, whether indoors or outdoors, to wear a face covering or mask when they cannot maintain 6 feet of distance between themselves and others, unless they have a medical condition preventing them from doing so.
- Masks are not required to be worn while swimming.
- Group Size: No groups larger than 10 are allowed to gather.
- Social distancing requires a minimum of 12 ft distance between towelings/beach blanket groups
- Organized ball games should not be allowed including, but not limited to, volleyball, Kan Jam, spikeball, football, soccer, Kadima, and bocce.
- A minimum distance of 6 feet shall be maintained between lifeguards and between the public and lifeguard stands unless in the case of an emergency.
- All rental boats, paddle boards and personal flotation devices will be cleaned and disinfected between use.
- Patrons must abide by social distancing standards for bathroom lines and follow any established visual guidelines for maintaining a 6' distance in all restroom facilities.
- Trash receptacles are available for normal use but patrons are encouraged to carry out all trash and recycling when possible.

**Violation or failure to follow these guidelines could lead to service refusal/expulsion from premises.**
